Warren served on active duty in the Air Force for 23 years, retiring in 1984, with the rank of Lt. Colonel. His first assignment was with the Headquarters, 78<sup>th</sup> Fighter Wing at Hamilton AFB, CA. He then served at 4683<sup>th</sup> Combat Support Group, then 438<sup>th</sup> Airborne AB Group, and Malmstrom AFB, MT (564<sup>th</sup> Strategic Missile Squadron), Philadelphia, PA (Student, Temple University), Missoula, MT (Student, University of Montana), Bowling Green, OH (Associate Professor APAS and PhD candidate, Bowling Green State University), Maxwell AFB, AL (Air Force ROTC), Europe (Headquarters, U.S. Air Force, Europe USAFE), Italy (Director of Personnel, 40<sup>th</sup> Combat Support Squadron).

After leaving active duty in the Air Force, Warren had a successful career in education and accounting. He worked for the University of Maryland European Division (Instructor) and then the Asia Region in Okinawa Japan & Korea (Lecturer and Accountant). He worked with the Black River Technical College (Adjunct Professor) and Arkansas State University (Adjunct Professor), Jones & Company (CPA) and Holy Angels Covenant (Business Manager). Warren passed away on 18 November 2024.
